The Poor Prisoners Defence Act

The Poor Prisoners Defence Act 1903 empowered courts to grant legal aid to a prisoner of insufficient means where it appeared "desirable in the interest of justice" and "having regard to the defence set up". This language was interpreted as limiting the grant of legal aid to cases where a defence was set up before the judge, thus excluding legal aid for pleas of guilty.

The Defense Production Act of 1950 is a United States federal law enacted on September 8, 1950 in response to the start of the Korean War. It was part of a broad civil defense and war mobilization effort in the context of the Cold War.
